The IES nº5, in collaboration with the Parents of Students Association (AMPA), announces the 4th Edition of the IES Nº 5 Literary Awards, under the following rules:

RULES:

- 1) All students at IES Nº 5 can participate.
- 2) The subject is free and the work must be original.
- 3) The same story cannot be presented in more than a language.
- 4) No more than one work in each category or modality must be presented.
- 5) It is established that two styles of works can be presented in different sections:
5.1 Narrative Fiction Contest
 - Four modalities: Spanish, Valencian, English and French languages.
 - Three categories: First cycle of ESO, Second cycle of ESO and Bachiller.
 - The minimum length will be two A4 double space sheets. The participants belonging to the First Cycle of ESO who take part in Valenciano the minimum length will be a sheet, the English and French modalities can present their work as a comic story which can be written by more than one person.

5.2 Poetry Contest

- Four modalities: Spanish, Valencian, English and French.
- Only one category.
- Maximum of three poetic compositions.

6) Participants must present:

- One copy, signed with a pseudonym or slogan, in paper, in a closed big envelope. Participants must write on the envelope "Para el IV Concurso Literario IES Nº 5 en (Castellano, Valenciano, Inglés o Francés) and specify the cycle (1r, 2n, or Bach)"
- Other copy must be sent by email to:

-Inside the big envelope, participants must include a small envelope which must have the title of their work written on it, and inside, a paper with the pseudonym or slogan and the personal information of the author: name, family names, phone number, level of studies, group and academic year.

- 7) The deadline for the presentation of the literary works will be 30th April 2012.
- 8) The works must be handed out in the School "Vicedirección" Office.
- 9) The organizers will set the prize money at 50€ for the First Award, and 20€ for the Second Award for each category.
- 10) The jury will be composed by the members of the IES Nº 5 Departments of Spanish, Valencian, English and French for the corresponding modalities.
- 11) The jury final decision will be published on the Note Board and in the School Website along June 2012.
- 12) The date and time of the presentation of the awards, which will take place during the Academic Year Closing Ceremony, will be communicated to the prizewinners.
- 13) The Jury decision will not be opened to appeal and they can declare the works not awarded, or give *ex-aequo* awards, in such a way that the money prize will be distributed equally. For the works presented in collaboration, the same rule will be applied.
- 14) The participation in the contest requires the acceptance of all the rules.
